# What Is the EYFS?

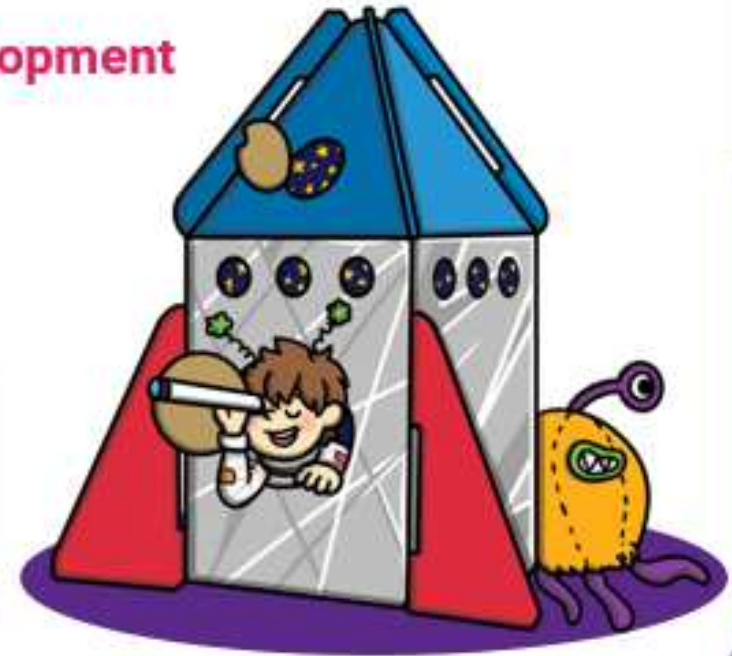
**The Early Years Foundation Stage** covers the first stage of a child's care from birth to five years old. It sets the standards to ensure that all children learn and develop, as well as keeping them healthy and safe.

All schools and Ofsted registered early years providers in England must follow the EYFS.

Also included in the EYFS are the **seven Areas of Learning**. They are:

- **Communication and Language**
- **Personal, Social and Emotional Development**
- **Physical Development**
- **Literacy**
- **Mathematics**
- **Understanding the World**
- **Expressive Arts and Design**

At the end of the EYFS, there are **17 Early Learning Goals** that children are expected to achieve.

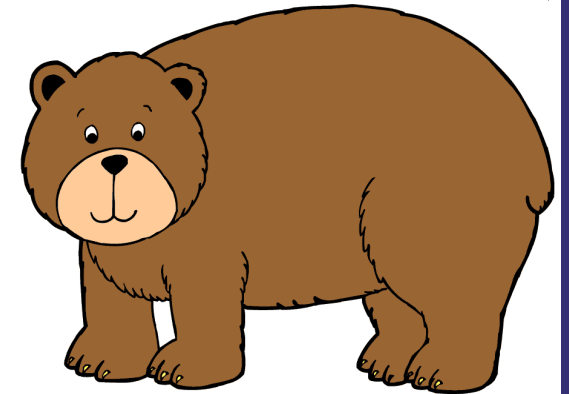
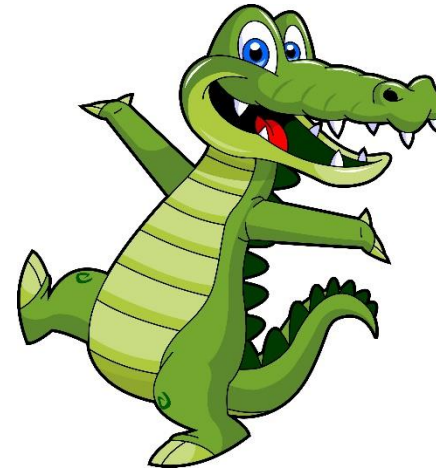

# School Uniform



On your child's PE day, they come into school PE ready in their kits. Our PE kit is a navy t-shirt and navy shorts or navy joggers when it is cold and suitable trainers. A warm navy top is a good idea when it is colder and the children are doing outdoor PE.

# What will my child need?

- All children must wear school uniform. Please ensure everything is clearly named.

- Appropriate clothing must be worn at all times as the children go outside in all weathers

- The children have access to water throughout the day.

- We ask that all children bring a named bottle filled with *water* every day

- At lunch children may have:

A packed lunch brought to school in a named lunchbox. We are a 'Healthy School' so we ask that children are given a healthy lunchbox with *no chocolate bars or sweets.*

*Or* A school dinner: which you can order via parent pay.

# Attendance

## Expectations

- Children are expected to be in school every day
- Anyone who does not come to school for whatever reason, should call in to the office on a daily basis (by 9am latest)
- If your child's attendance drops below **96%** you will receive a letter encouraging you to work with the school to improve it
- Attendance that drops below **90%** is persistent absence. We monitor these cases under '**Attendance Watch**'
