What Is the EYFS?

The Early Years Foundation Stage covers the first stage of a child's care from birth to five years old. It sets the standards to ensure that all children learn and develop, as well as keeping them healthy and safe.

All schools and Ofsted registered early years providers in England must follow the EYFS.

Also included in the EYFS are the seven Areas of Learning. They are:

Communication and Language

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

- Physical Development
- Literacy
- Mathematics
- Understanding the World
- Expressive Arts and Design

At the end of the EYFS, there are 17 Early Learning Goals that children are expected to achieve.

- ■We ask that all children bring a named bottle filled with water every day
- At lunch children may have:

<u>A packed lunch</u> brought to school in a named lunchbox. We are a 'Healthy School' so we ask that children are given a healthy lunchbox with *no chocolate bars or sweets*.

- If your child's attendance drops below 96% you will receive a letter encouraging you to work with the school to improve it
- Attendance that drops below 90% is persistent absence. We monitor these cases under 'Attendance Watch'
