

## As writers we will be:

Giving meaning to the marks we make when drawing or painting. We will be mark making in our play and will attempt to write our own names with our early writing skills.



## As mathematicians we will be:

Learning the stable order of objects; counting one number for each object we touch. We will be learning to recognise numerals 1-10 and applying our knowledge and vocabulary into our play.



## As communicators we will be:

Listening to others 1 to 1 or in small groups and listening to familiar stories with increasing attentions and recall. Building up our vocabulary from learnt experiences.
