At Heronshaw School our curriculum is enriched through extracurricular activities that run during and after school. The clubs we provide are of children's interest and we are always changing the clubs half-termly to engage children to gain new experiences and skills. These extracurricular activities have been very beneficial to enhance children's self-confidence and self-esteem, as well as keeping them healthy and active. Run by school-based staff as well as external agencies, we offer expert enrichment opportunities covering sports, the arts, STEM themes and lots more. Each half term clubs are shared and parents can sign up to electronically via MCAS. Please note clubs are assigned on a first-come, first served basis; please do sign up quickly to secure a place for your child. Prices for clubs vary depending on the nature of the activity and to cover the costs of materials or external coaches.

We offer private acoustic guitar lessons with Mr Finch (Strum-into-Music), and the opportunity to learn to play an instrument in a Rocksteady band. These bands are formed of guitarists, keyboard players, drummers and vocalists. Each week the musicians come together to learn a new music skill as they work collaboratively to play a section of a well-known track each week.
