We are very excited that our visit to Milton Keynes Theatre for ***Cinderella*** is quickly approaching! Please find below the final arrangements for the visit on **Tuesday 19th December**. Please read this information carefully so that your child is fully prepared for the trip.

Arrival and Departure

We will be departing from the school at **11:55am**, by coach. Please ensure your child arrives at school at normal time. We are due to return to the school at approximately **3:45pm**. All children will then return to their classrooms to collect home time things before being released by their class teachers at their usual location. We will keep you informed via social media should there be any delays.

What to bring

Children should bring a packed lunch, which we will eat at school ahead of leaving for the theatre. If you have already registered your child for a school meal on this day, please note it will be automatically substituted for a *cheese roll packed lunch*. Should you not wish your child to have this please provide alternative lunch.

Please do not send your children with any pocket money, there will not be the opportunity to purchase any merchandise or refreshments. An interval ice cream has been allocated to every child. Please ensure that you have reminded your class teacher if your child cannot have this as an alternative can be provided.

What to wear

Please send your child in wearing correct Heronshaw School uniform, including school shoes.
